CALL TO ORDER

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Duke updated the meeting and confirmed that he Flowers sea swim is going to be a one mile. There won't be a 3K and 10K.

Open Water:

Duke updated the meeting. The CUC sea swim went well despite the sprint meet taking place in the morning on that Saturday. The Canada Open Water trials is likely to be schedule in November 2021..

Duke confirmed that Butterfield will let us know by month end if they will be continuing with the sponsorship of the sea swim.

A Masters synchro program has started and currently has about 10 participants.

Nationals:

Discussion surrounded the hire of a photographer. Kathy suggested a photographer, Caroline Deegan, who could do the photos for Sunday morning. It was agreed that this would allow for photos of the younger swimmers as well as older swimmers, which would encompass a good range of photos.

Duke and Sandy confirmed that the sign up genius list has gone out for the timekeepers, computer console, first responders, concession. A request is being made to club representatives to ask their members to sign up for timekeeping.

There is a plan to have two short synchro shows during the meet.

The official opening of the meet with a government official will take place on Thursday 18 February 2021 at 5.30pm.

Technical / FINA

It was confirmed by three people signed up for artistic swimming judge clinic: Donna Graham, Mary Ellen Carnahan and Helena Frawley.

Medical / Lifeguards / Safety

Steve confirmed that the Cayman Islands government has purchased an AED machine for the Lions poo. Steve suggested that CIASA buy an AED training unit . It was also confirmed that Dean was checking with Dart with the safety equipment for the Camana Bay Sports Complex pool. Kathy confirmed that she could also check.

TECHNICAL DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Bailey tabled his report.

Discussion surrounded the SSC plan to add a beginner group to the team. The meeting discussed and agreed that the swimmers in that group should be able to swim for at least 25 metres. Marz confirmed that currently there are 8 swimmers targeted for that group. The question of safety first was brought up by Steve.

CBAC

Last weekend saw a artistic virtual meet which saw about 50 of the younger athletes take part from Aruba, Jamaica and Cayman. It was confirmed that there will be a virtual meet in the last weekend in February 2021 for older kids. Currently the synchro team is made up of 80 members, which includes 2 boys; currently 8 athletes are doing junior coaching; two of them are being paid.

This coming weekend, there will be STARR testing, which are tests performed to test the athletes' level of standard.

Currently, CBAC are looking to host Spring Splash from 26th to 28th March. Sandy will speak to Hayley about the meet as Friday 26 March 2021 is the date of the CIASA golf day.

Sally updated the meeting with regards to new material and letter with regards to fund development and a revised Letter for Request of Sponsorship.

Sally asked whether CIASA has thought of a 'Go Fund Me' The meeting discussed this and thought the treasurer needed to be consulted on this.

The idea of the lanes sponsored by a company at meets was brought up. Sally is to discuss this with the technical committee.

The idea of getting a sponsored meet program and booklet was also discussed for the next Nationals.

Sally confirmed that we have received \$5K from an anonymous donor and \$2K from Faith and Jimi Crooks.

CIASA thanks our donors for their contribution to Cayman aquatics.

Sally will circulate the revised Letter of Request to the Board for review and approval.

Booster

Sandy tabled her report.

The tshirt press is working and ready for the Nationals. Tshirts will be sold at \$20 and if an extra 'sticker' is put on the back, the shirts will be sold for \$25.

If we sell 170 shirts, we should be able to make CI\$2000.

Golf tournament will take place on Friday 26 March 2021. Trac has donated to us the hole in 1 prize this year. The idea of the photos of CIASA faces will be posted around the golf course and participants will be able to purchase them.
