Apologies were received from Andrew MacKay, Michelle Bailey, CJ Moore, Frank Flowers and Anup Itwar.

CALL TO ORDER

Michael Lockwood called the meeting to order at 6.38pm. It was noted that a quorum of the board of directors (the "Board") of the Cayman Islands Aquatic Sports Association ("CIASA") was present in person.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on 10 October 2018 were tabled at the meeting. Following discussion, on a motion duly moved, and seconded, it was resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on be approved.

MATTERS ARISING:

Flowers Sea Swim:

There were no new updates.

It was noted that UANA is planning to have an Open Water circuit and will have 10 events around the Caribbean and Central/South America.

Michael suggested that we put together a memorandum with regards to the Flowers sea swims in June 2019 with regards to the 3K and 10K swims. Denny Ryther is to be consulted.

President's Report:

Michael tabled his report.

The AGM will be taking place on Wednesday 14 November 2018 at the Cayman Prep and High School Hall on Walkers Road at 7pm.

Currently, we have one director stepping down who will not be putting his name forward for re-election; CJ Moore. Michael asked the meeting to have a think with regards to any possible names and nominations for this role. Michael would like to thank CJ for his work as the Fund Development Director.

SUB-COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Open Water:

Bailey updated the meeting about the Canadian Open Water National event taking place in Cayman in April 2019. Currently, the team is looking into the timing system.

This event will take place the weekend of the 27th and 28th April 2019. The event will consist of a 10K race and expected to have 40-50 swimmers. The Chief referee and Chief medical person will be provided by the Canadian National team.

The date for the event is good timing for using as a qualifier.

Duke informed the meeting that the Pirates 5K set to go. The race will take place at Governors Beach and consist of four loops. Colleen Williams will be the referee.

After discussion, and seeing the marathon is on 1 December 2018, it was decided that the CUC sea swim be deferred from 30 November to 12 January 2019.

Masters and Aquatic Sports:

Nationals:

Bailey informed the meeting that the request proposal for the pool and facilities was being completed in the next week. We know that for the upcoming nationals, we will not be getting sponsorship in the form of fencing, chairs, and tents. Bailey will contact Kirk at CBAC to ask about the tents, chairs and lights. Discussion surrounded CIASA purchase tents and chairs to have for use now and in the future. Steve informed the meeting that the Nationals will be televised live.

It was discussed and agreed that the CIASA 5K take place on Saturday 23 February 2019.

Technical:

Bailey informed the meeting that FINA has stopped doing clinics for water polo and synchronised swimming.

Medical/Lifeguards/Safety:

Discussion surrounded that a Lifeguard course needs to take place this swim year so as we can get more certified lifeguards to add to the roster. Chilian was to contact Fitness Connection to enquire on the next lifeguard course.

The meeting was informed that the 8 lane 25 meter pool is ready to use.

Furthermore, the meeting was informed that the Cayman Brac Club is planning to register as a club with CIASA.
